



REAL STEEL ART GALLERY DEMONSTRATION DESCRIPTION OF "THE RAINBONADO"

INTRODUCTION

I am Derek Tudor, a Multi-interdisciplinary Artist, the CEO of Derek Tudor Arts, The Real Steel Art Gallery, So Trendy A2Z & The Mini Van Go Mobile Art Gallery.

I started creating steel artwork to further explore the concept of beauty. All mediums are celebrated for its beauty but I feel that there is more that can be done with steel. My favorite things I like to create with steel are animals & nature.

Demonstration Description

The demonstration I am going to do is a piece called Rainbonado (which is my vision if a rainbow and a tornado had a baby, lol) that will be grinder into a sheet on stainless steel. Just how normal artists use canvasses, wood & other mediums, I am taking some stainless steel that you might see everyday or have it your kitchen and I'm going to make it POP by grinding deep into it in some spots and grind lightly into it in other spots to get the reflection off of it, and you will see millions of little cuts like facets in a diamond, all from my grinding tools. So the tools I am using is a large air compressor to power my angle grinder & air sanders, a dremel detailing tool, transparent paints, paint brushes, a sheet of stainless steel and possibly a blow dryer if needed.

1st) I will use the angle grinder to freestyle an outline of the awesome Rainbonado, using a very rough grinding pad #50.

2nd) I will use a sander to sand the bottom corner that will represent the land later when the piece finished.

3rd) I will take the angle grinder and change the grinding pad to a very mild pad (#120, the higher the number the less course or rough it is) to fill in the outlines of the Rainbonado, which will be swirling around like an actual tornado.

4th) I will take the grinder with the rough pad (#50) again and go over the outline to define it, because when I fill it in I can go over the outline and make it less noticeable.

5th) I will use the Dremel tool to detail any areas that's needed and to also sign my name into the stainless steel when I am done.

6th) I will use the transparent paint to paint the swirls of the Rainbonado with every bright beautiful color in a regular rainbow, and then paint the lower corner with a light brown to be the ground that the Rainbonado is swirling on.

7th) Finally, I will spray a high gloss clear coat of protective spray paint to make the piece shine & pop even more.

This would conclude my demonstration and I would sign "Derek Tudor & the date" with the dremel detailer.
