

REAL STEEL ART GALLERY "DEMONSTRATION DESCRIPTION "

INTRODUCTION

I am Derek Tuder, a Multi-interdisciplinary Artist, the CEO of Derek Tuder Arts, The Real Steel Art Gallery, So Trendy A2Z & The Mini Van Go Mobile Art Gallery.

I started creating steel artwork to further explore the concept of beauty. All mediums are celebrated for its beauty but I feel that there is more that can be done with steel. My favorite things I like to create with steel are animals & nature.

Demonstration Description

The demonstration I am going to do is a freehand Winter Wonderland scenery that will be grinder into a sheet on stainless steel. Just how normal artists use canvasses, wood & other mediums, I am taking some stainless steel that you might see or have it your kitchen and I'm going to make it POP by grinding deep into it in some spots and grind lightly into it in other spots to get the reflection off of it, and you will see millions of little cuts like facets on a diamond, all from my grinding tools.

So the tools I am using is a large air compressor to power my angle grinder & air sanders, a dremel detailing tool, transparent paints, paint brushes, a sheet of stainless steel and possibly a blow dryer & hand blow torch if needed.

- 1st) I will use the sander to sand the lower half of the sheet of stainless steel to lay down the winter wonderland's ground snow, which you can't tell what it is right now.
- 2nd) I will use the angle grinder to create a cool looking border around the entire edge of the sheet.
- 3rd) I take the angle grinder and start making some mountains in the background, then some clouds, a sunset and some birds in the sky. These objects are placed first to give the picture that depth perception when the rest is added.
- 4th) I take the same grinder and in the middle of the picture I'll create some trees in the left and right far sides on the picture, then I will make a small house off centered with 1 front window, a door, a chimney with smoke coming out of it. I will make a fence in the back of the house going across to the tree and then a walkway coming from the front door to the front on the picture.
- 5th) with the same grinder I will make some shrubs & lil bushes in from of the picture that will look like they are about to jump out of the scene.
- 6th) I will use the Dremel tool to detail some items as needed that I can not get to with the grinder such as: the door knob, tree's bases, mountain's peeks, the fence's base etc...
- 7th) I will use the transparent paint to paint the trees green, the snow white, the mountain brown, the house bright & colorful, the clouds white, the sky light blue and a beautiful sunset full of red, orange, purple & yellow.

This would conclude my demonstration after I would sign "Derek Tuder & the date" with the dremel detailer.
