

## **YUKIKO KIKUCHI – PAPER CRAFTS**

Yukiko began paper crafting for a charity event. Her work was very well received as ornaments for decorating trees during the holiday season.

Yukiko's paper craft process consists of:

- Selecting the type/weight of paper to use
- Selecting the color/pattern of paper to use
- Carefully folding the paper into small pieces that are used to make up the finished piece
- Selecting the pieces of different colors and patterns that make up the finished piece
- Engaging 24 pieces to make up the finished piece

Small pieces that make up the final piece must be folded precisely, with all corners matching, so that they can be assembled into a perfect sphere.

Choosing the right color/pattern of the 24 small pieces is crucial to the overall design of the finished piece.

These small pieces are fitted into each other tightly, without the use of chemical adhesives, thus making the creation process mess-free and safe.
